Subject: Williamson County Landfill Price Adjustment

Dear Judge Gravell:

Pursuant to Article III, Section 3.2 of the March 3, 2009, Williamson County Landfill Operation Agreement between Williamson County and Waste Management of Texas, Inc., Waste Management may increase the Tip Fee with advance written notice to the County. The purpose of this letter is to notify the County that based upon current market conditions a \$3.00 per ton or 6% Tip Fee adjustment will be effective August 1, 2024.

Current Tip Fee:

\$49.90 per ton + TCEQ fee, Williamson County fees, and fuel surcharge, if applicable

New Tip Fee Effective June 1, 2023:

\$52.90 per ton + TCEQ fee, Williamson County fees, and fuel surcharge, if applicable

The Tip Fee for all cars and pickups without trailers will increase from at a flat rate of \$40.00/vehicle plus Fees to \$45.00/ton plus Fees. A one-ton minimum will apply to all other vehicles plus applicable fees. The *brush* rate will also increase effective August 1, 2024, from \$8.50/cubic yard to \$9.50/cubic yard. The County funds and host fees that are passed through to County will increase from \$2.99/ton to \$3.17/ton once the new Tip Fee takes effect.

Other Fees that will increase are as follows.

No-Tarp Fee will increase from \$25/load to \$30/load.

Pull-Off Fee will increase from \$25/load to \$30/load.

Effective August 1<sup>st</sup>, cash will no longer be accepted. Only credit accounts, credit cards, debit cards or pre-paid debit cards will be accepted for payment.
